

## 1911 Census for **Isle Abbots. Langport Dist 12 307-2**

1901 census figures in brackets: No. of males 98 (131); No. of females 106 (134); no. of schedules (houses) 46 (57). 63 men were working on 7 farms – Two Bridges, Manor, Brome’s Northalls, Woodlands, Higher Woodlands and School Farms. 12 women were employed as shirtmakers (prob at the shirt factory in Westport). There were 43 children at the village school.
