- 22/98 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST & DISPENSATIONS

 Cllr Richards declared an interest in planning application 21/00409/FUL.
- 22/99 The MINUTES of the Ordinary meeting held on Wednesday 7th September 2022 were approved as a correct record and duly signed by the Chair.
- 22/100 MATTERS ARISING. a) Posts for protection to the bus shelter is still to be investigated. ACTION: Cllr Richards to contact Highways for advice. b) Purchase of a dog waste bin: Item to be put on hold until services are aligned as part of re-organisation to a single authority and implementation of Local Community Networks. c) Recycling: There have been no recent reports of issues of missed collections.

 An update on possible renovation of the telephone box was requested. ACTION: Cllrs Richards & J

 Westworth advised they would contact the owners to see what could be agreed.

22/102 PLANNING APPLICATIONS:

- a) APPLICATION NO. 22/02060/COU: Land at Woodlands Farm, Woodlands Lane, Isle Abbots TA3 6RT Change of use from agricultural land to equestrian. All councillors abstained from voting to support or object to the application; however, all agreed to submitting observations regarding safety concerns due to increased traffic along the access road, which is a single lane with only one passing place and also is an emergency exit/access for Merryfield Airfield.
- b) APPLICATION NO. 21/00409/FUL: Land at Isle Abbotts TA3 6RR Change of use of agricultural land to residential for the erection of 2 No. single storey dwellings with garaging & shared vehicular access and a track and gate to serve the adjoining agricultural land. Due to declared interest of Cllr Richards and resulting exclusion from discussions, the council was unable to consider this item as there were not enough members to be quorate. The item will be deferred to the next council meeting.
- 22/103 ROADS (LL) Cllr Lockley advised that she had enquired regarding a 'no through road' sign to prevent vehicles unnecessarily routing through the village. Traffic Management advised that as it is not a deadend, such signage would not be permissible.
 Cllr Lockley advised she has been investigating costs of entryway signs for Isle Abbotts, which are approximately £300 each. Cllr Lockley is looking into potential funding sources to cover these costs. The item will be deferred to the next Ordinary council meeting.
